Dear Parents and Girls,

Welcome to a new year of Pioneer Girls! We are looking forward to another great year of learning about Christ, making crafts and tasty food, going on field trips, doing service projects, and making friends. It is our goal to fulfill the Pioneer Girls' motto of Christ in every aspect of life.

Pioneer Girls is open to all girls in grades K through 12. We encourage girls to tell others and to bring their friends.

There is some important information for you to know as we enter our new year:

- This year, I will again be serving as coordinator. I am excited to be leading the program and I pray that this year sees tremendous growth in all of the girls. Please contact me (662-2304) if you have any questions or concerns about the program.
- Parents are requested to come into the building for pick-up. No child, no matter her age, will be released from either the church building or the Christian Education building without an adult. This is for the girls' safety.
- The fee for this year is \$25 per girl, \$40 per family if more than one girl is in our program. Registration again this year includes a Pioneer Girls shirt, to be passed out during the second or third week. Complete registration forms and permission slips must be on file for any girl to participate in our program.
- Groups are capped at 8 girls per leader (for a total of 16 or 24 girls per group). This is also for the safety of the girls. Registration will be accepted on a first come-first served basis. Each girl MUST be in her own age group. Registration into a different age group to be with particular friends will not be allowed. Registrations may be mailed to the church before Opening Night (7295 Ellicott Road; Orchard Park, 14127), or girls may bring them on Opening Night.
- All girls are encouraged to wear their t-shirts every week to club.
- This year, we are continuing to ask girls to wear their sashes the first Wednesday of every month. The girls work hard to earn their badges and we want to honor that effort. All girls receive a sash when they join the group. If your daughter loses her sash, replacements are available for \$5.
- Parents are always welcome at any time...come to help, come to visit. We can always use extra hands for crafts and cooking, drivers for field trips, etc.
- We will have two bring-a-friend nights this year. Please encourage your daughter to bring someone new to club for a visit. Of course, if your daughter has a friend who would like to visit or join club at any time, we always welcome that.

Opening Night is September 12. Again this year, we would like to invite parents to join their daughters for the first portion of the evening to meet the leaders and join us for a few songs. We will also be starting the year with a field trip in the October. We will be leading a sing-a-long for the residents of Orchard Heights. Parent drivers are appreciated and you can join singing if you wish! All girls must have written permission to attend the field trip—that form is enclosed.

Thank you for making Pioneer Girls a part of your week and a part of your lives. We look forward to a fun-filled year with you and your daughter.
